Sweeper Attachments - AUSA lift trucks provide supreme functionality and are truly popular for their compact, ergonomic and highly modular design. They provide versatility and stability when handling loads on the job location and are considered very dependable. With respect to various forklifts, AUSA units have a big diameter of their wheels which helps to guarantee favorable weight suspension in the cab and in the blades.
